

How to Apply as a Secondary Non-Degree-Seeking Student

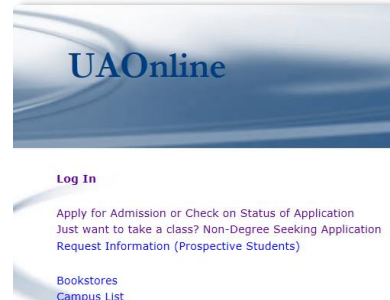
Secondary students (student in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade)

Non-Degree seeking students are not eligible for financial aid.

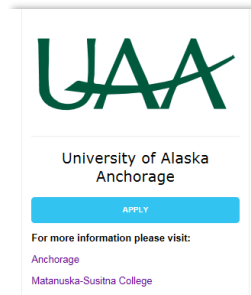

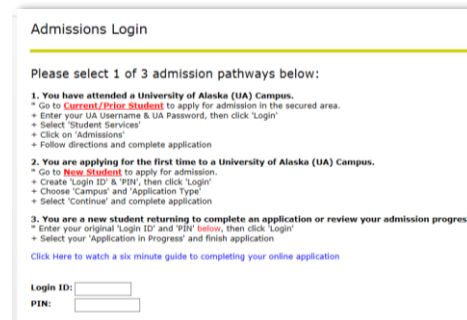
If you have never taken classes within the university system.
