Karen Mattson – Intermediate/Advanced Watercolor Supplies

Watercolors:

- Aurulean Yellow
- New Gamboge
- Quinocrodone Rose or any Rose
- Cobalt Blue
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Napthal Red or Windsor Red (any true red)
- Diazonine Purple
- Thalo Green
- Indigo

Watercolor palette (Quiller, wood, etc.)

Masking fluid

Small brush (old or ugly) for masking fluid & small soap

Rubber mask remover

Artist painting tape

2 - water containers

Paper towels

Stapler for mounting paper onto Gatorboard*

Salt (gourmet or sea salt works best)

Brushes: #6, #8 and #12 Round Watercolor Brushes

1½" - 2" Flat Brush

1 - 140# Arches watercolor paper 22" x 30" (see note below)

Cut in half so you have 1 - 22" x 15"

Cut the other half in half, so you have 2 - 11" x 11"

*Gatorboard a little larger than 15" x 22" for stapling/taping the watercolor paper to. This is a must to do the techniques you will be learning.

Note: I will not accept Strathmore paper. You will not be happy with the results due to poor quality paper.
