



CTSO Performance-Based Assessment Scholarship Application

Deadline to Apply: April 5, 2024 by 11:59 p.m.

Open to high school seniors graduating in May 2024 and preparing to attend Mat-Su College of the University of Alaska Anchorage during the 2024-2025 academic year. Award waives 24 credits of tuition applicable to Mat-Su College courses only (up to 12 credits each semester for Fall 2024 and Spring 2025).

To be eligible, applicants must:

- 1) Be a high school senior graduating in May 2024 and a member of an Alaska Career & Technical Student Organization (CTSO). These include BPA, DECA, FCCLA, EdRising, FFA, HOSA, & SkillsUSA.
- 2) Have earned a minimum GPA of 2.75 or higher in high school
- 3) Be registered or planning to register for classes at Mat-Su College for the fall 2024 semester

To apply:

- 1) Apply for admission as an Undergraduate to any degree program offered by Mat-Su College
- 2) Submit an official high school transcript.
- 3) Complete the Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) Application form by the deadline: **April 5, 2024, by 11:59 p.m.**
