### Deadline to Apply: April 2, 2021 by 11:59 p.m.

Open to high school seniors graduating in May 2021 and preparing to attend Mat-Su College of the University of Alaska Anchorage during the 2021-2022 academic year. Award waives 24 credits of tuition applicable to Mat-Su College courses only (up to 12 credits each semester for Fall 2021 and Spring 2022).

#### To be eligible, applicants must:

- 1) Be a high school senior graduating in May 2021 and a member of an Alaska Career & Technical Student Organization (CTSO). These include BPA, DECA, FCCLA, EdRising, FFA, HOSA, & SkillsUSA.
- 2) Have earned a minimum GPA of 2.75 or higher in high school
- 3) Be registered or planning to register for classes at Mat-Su College for the fall 2021 semester

- 2) Submit an official high school transcript.
